Another Fuzzy Mountain/Hollow Rock String Band tune, probably originally from Henry Reed. I've sometimes heard it called "Cold and Frosty Morning." This is set in GDGAD. What makes this tune is the nice little run up in the B part. In measure 15, there is a ghost note just to remind you to let the third string continue to ring into the next measure. It doesn't get picked again (that is, until measure 16).
