Yew Piney Mountain is a West Virginia tune with a very unusual "crooked" structure, meaning that it has a number of extra beats in various places. I have heard a number of different versions of this tune; this arrangement is based upon the playing of fiddler French Carpenter. Note that the tuning is gDGAD, capoed on the second fret, so that you are in the key of A Mixolydian. More or less.
