Another tune from the great Kentucky fiddler J.P. Fraley. I worked this up in my G variant tuning (gDGAD), but since it's fiddled in A, you will need to capo on the 2nd fret. Note that the B part, the low part, is twice as long as the A, or high part.. It has been suggested that the "nine yards of calico" was slang for a woman, as it took nine yards to make a dress.
